- 5. A Soul Cleansing Traditional Kathak Dance Piece (solo) by NUPUR, the Indian Dance Society, KNC.
- 6. Oath taking ceremony by the staff, students and faculty members of the college with Vice Principal Dr. Rita Malhotra
- 7. Competitions on the mission of cleanliness held were the following
 - i) Poster Making
 - ii) Best Slogan
 - iii) Best out of waste
- 8. The one hour weekly ECA break at KNC on Thursdays was formally declared as the weekly cleanliness hour of KNC.
- 9. NCC, NSS, NSO volunteers joined the teaching and non-teaching staff as well as students to engage in the participatory cleanliness Abhiyan.
