## 2021-2022

-On 21<sup>st</sup> June,2021 on the occasion of **International Yoga Day** an online workshop was conducted by Priyamvada Tripathi.

-The Department of **Physical Education** celebrated International Day of Yoga and conducted a Live Session on Yoga for Total Fitness on 21st June, 2021. A lecture on Sports psychology for Performance Enhancement was organised in September with Dr. Lalit Sharma, Professor from Indira Gandhi Institute of Physical Education and Sports Sciences, University of Delhi as the speaker.

- The college celebrated the **Independence day** on 15<sup>th</sup> August'2021 with a well-organized event comprising of Flag hoisting, events and songs put together by the NCC cadets on college campus.

The college celebrated **the Republic day** on 26<sup>th</sup> January. 2022. The NCC cadets had put together a wonderful event with playing of band, songs and poems along with the address by the Principal Prof. Kalpana Bhakuni.

-Women's Development Cell organized a social media campaign 23rd February -27th February WDC celebrated **Black History Month** by giving tribute to female activists –Harriet Tubman, Rosa Park, Myrlie Louise Evers, Dr. June Jackson Christmas, Leah Chase, Fannie Lou Hamer, Marsha P Johnson.

We have also had the pleasure to invite Col K.S Bisht, CO 4DGBN to celebrate Army Day with us who motivated the cadets and extended his support to us.

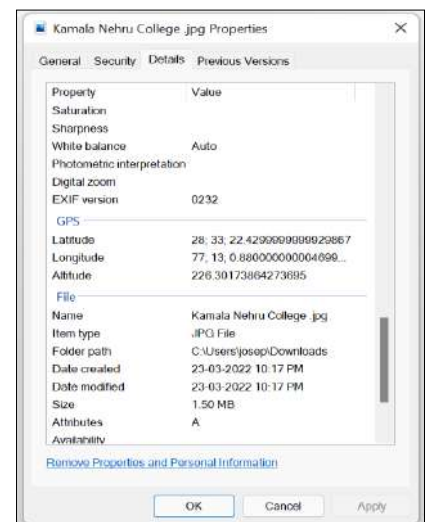

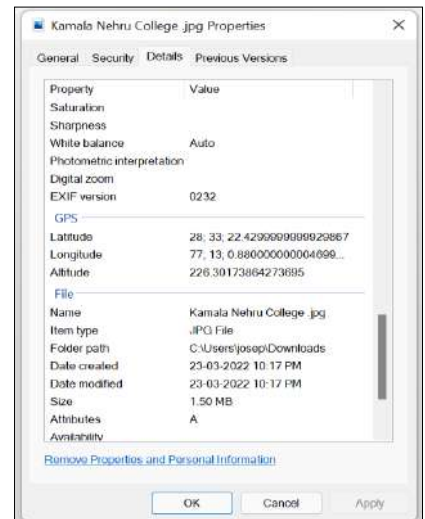




Surgical Strike Day Commemoration by National Cadet Corps

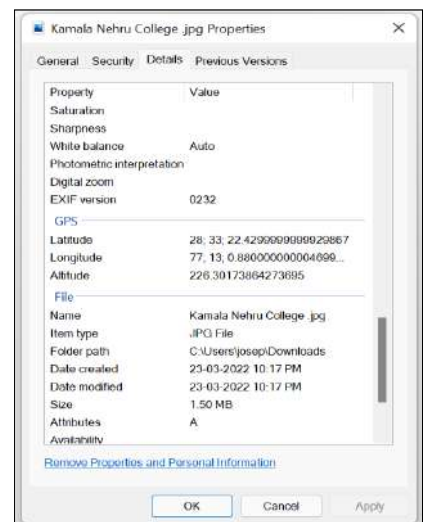
