**3 Term** \* MOU-This MOU is effective upon the day and date last signed and executed by the duly authorised representatives of the parties to this MOU and shall remain in full force and effect for not longer than one year (Jan Dec, 2021) This MOU may be terminated, without cause, by either party with 30 days written notice, which notice shall be delivered by hand or by certified post to the address listed above.

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#### 4 Responsibilities of collaborating colleges .

I- The faculty members of both the colleges mutually exchange the students and teach them as per syllabus only

II- There will be no remunerations involved for either faculty besides their regular salary .

III- The choice of topic to be taught will rest upon the teacher and mutually agreed upon by both the colleges

IV- Though there is no binding of number of classes to be taken for the students under exchange program but it would be desirable that it should not be fragmented and incomplete

V- The exchange program does not entail the internal assessment /test to be added /credited at the parent institution .However, the syllabus covered would be taken into the account .

VI- The classes will be held over and above the workload assigned to the faculty of both the colleges

VII- Such classes should not clash with the regular time table of the faculty .

VIII- Certificates will be awarded to the faculty of both the colleges engaged in teaching under Student - Faculty exchange program certified by the Principals of both the colleges at the end of respective semester specifying the number of classes taken .

#### 5 General Provisions

A. **Amendments:** Either party may request changes to this MOU. Any changes, modifications, revisions, or amendments to this MOU which are mutually agreed upon by and between the parties to this MOU shall be incorporated by written instruments, and effective when executed and signed by all parties to this MOU.

B. **Entirety of Agreement:** This MOU, consisting of four pages, represents the entire and integrated agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, and agreements, whether written or oral.

C. **Third-Party Beneficiary Rights:** The parties do not intend to create in any other individual or entity the status of a third-party beneficiary, and this MoU shall not be constructed so as to create such status. The rights, duties, and obligations contained in this MOU shall operate only between the parties to this MOU, and shall inure solely to the benefit of the parties to this MOU. The provisions of this MOU are intended only to assist the parties in determining and performing their obligations under this MOU .The parties to this MOU intend and ex-

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## STATEMENT OF PROPOSAL

1. This collaboration is based on a proposal for the design and implementation of Indoor Navigation Assistance Solution to be implemented at Kamala Nehru College Campus, University of Delhi
2. This research project would be based on a pilot installation and study to be carried out in the Ground, First and Second floors of the Main building at Kamala Nehru College.
3. From the elementary survey at various venues (i.e. hospitals, public buildings and academic institutions), it has been found that wayfinding is a challenge for people with disabilities, especially visual disability. Inadequate and non-strategic placement of signage also adds to this wayfinding challenge. It is further complicated for visitors who are not familiar with the local language and have limited visual sensory abilities.
4. We believe a technology-based solution using smartphones would be able to address this challenge for people with a visual disability (PVDs) and will also be useful to mainstream users.
5. An effective indoor wayfinding system depends on formulation of key components that includes: visual accessibility, actual and ideal path, decision points identification, strategic inclusion of essential information over map, cognitive map modeling of the facility.
6. In this project, comprehensive digital mapping will include field survey, area division, information sourcing, mapping and its validation. Further, localization using bluetooth beacons to support real time indoor navigation is planned.
7. The key initial objective of this collaboration would be to understand the existing area division, flow patterns, navigation/wayfinding challenges as well as accessibility issues. The aim would be to implement a unique solution that can address the wayfinding challenges. Further, a gradual evolution eliminates the need for major adaptation and retraining requirements of major stakeholders.

## IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

1. Total duration of the project will be 12 months. The project will be implemented in two phases. **Phase one** will include creating an accessible digital map of the college campus venue. Duration of phase 1 will be 2 months. This includes division of area/zone based on their functioning like "Academic, Administrative, Classroom, Cafeteria and Lab-etc", field survey, information sourcing, validation and annotation over existing venue map.
2. **Phase two** will include identification of locations and installation of bluetooth beacons to support real time navigation. Combined with the annotated digital map in phase 1, this would help solve the independent and real time navigation challenge of all types of visitors keeping PVDs as the central focus. The duration for stage two will be 4 months after completion of phase 1. This phase will also include testing, refinement and validation of the system.
3. Final validation reports will be generated including the inputs and feedback from users/students and the college staff after successful implementation of the navigation system. Assitech Lab will extend the support including service, maintenance and upgrades for 6 months after completion of phase 2.

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4. After completion of a total of 12 months, the existing installation and services can be maintained by any third party like Raised Line Foundation (A non-for-profit startup from Assistech Lab, IIT Delhi) or the locally trained staff/students at Kamala Nehru College.

#### ROLE OF PARTIES

1. The contribution of the project would include site survey, training and mapping and implementation of real time navigation system as mentioned previously.

*Role of Assistech Lab, IIT Delhi,*

- Provide and resolve any type of technical query related to project
- Training students/faculty of Kamala Nehru College on field survey and annotation tool
- Installation testing of beacon based real time navigation
- Testing and validation report for annotation and navigation application

*Role of Kamala Nehru College,*

- Students of geography may be involved in field surveys & digital mapping as interns/trainees
- Testing and validation report for the navigation application
- Local publicity, outreach and awareness of the project,

Note: Kamala Nehru college will assign a local representative and interested student on this project to deliver on the items listed in its role.

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## ANNEXURE - I

### ARTICLE 1 : DETAILED SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

1.1 Subject to the provisions of this Agreement, the Parties contemplate, agree and undertake to put in best of their endeavor to perform, carry out and accomplish the Research Work to its fullest possible extent in spirit, essence and form.

1.2 Each of the Parties individually undertakes and agrees to put their best efforts to carry out and accomplish the specific parts of the Research Work as may be assigned to them by mutual agreement between the Parties.

1.3 The Parties do not represent or warrant that the Research Work or any part of it assigned to each of the Parties will be successful in any way or that any specific results will be obtained.

1.4 Unless changed by specific written notice given by IITD to the other Parties, the conduct of IITDs obligations and activities under this Agreement shall be carried out under the direction and supervision of a team of faculty members consisting of Prof. P.V.Madhusudhan Rao and Prof. M.Balakrishnan and the team so constituted will be headed by Prof. P.V.Madhusudhan Rao. (hereafter referred to as the PI).

1.5 Any research materials of one Party transferred to the other Party in connection with this Agreement may only be used for the Research Work.

1.6 Unless the Parties agree otherwise, research materials are to be considered as the "Confidential Information" of the Party providing them.

1.7 The Parties from time to time will keep the other Parties informed about the results and outcomes of the work carried out and performed by it under its obligations through their PI and Co-PIs.

1.8 If during the course of carrying out the research the Parties consider it advantageous and desirable to amend and modify the scope of the Research Work for better and effective deliverable and outcome, Parties may mutually do so by an amendment.

### ARTICLE 2 : CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

2.1 In this Article Confidential Information means confidential scientific, business or financial data or information owned by the Parties which will be marked as such in writing provided that such information: (a) is not publicly known or available from other sources who are not under a confidentiality obligation to the source of the information (b) is not already known by or available to the receiving party without a confidentiality obligation and (c) is not independently developed by the receiving party.

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2.2 Each of the Parties' acceptance and use of any confidential information supplied by the other Party in the course of the Research Work will be subject to the following: (a) to be considered Confidential Information, all written information must be marked or designated in writing as CONFIDENTIAL by the party providing the information, and oral communications must be reduced to writing within thirty (30) days of the initial communication of the information and such writing must be marked or designated in writing as CONFIDENTIAL and provided to the other Party's PI or Co-PIs, as the case may be.

2.3 The PI and the Co-PIs will use reasonable efforts to limit the exchange of Confidential Information.

2.4 Where the PI or Co-PIs does accept such information as confidential, he agrees to use the same degree of care to prevent the unauthorized use of the Confidential Information, as the Party supplying would have reasonably taken to prevent its unauthorized use.

### ARTICLE 3 : ACADEMIC FREEDOM AND PUBLICATION

3.1 Nothing in this Agreement will be construed to limit the freedom of Parties or its faculty members and researchers from engaging in similar research made under other grants, contracts, or research agreements.

3.2 As a matter of basic academic freedom, the Parties and their faculty members and researchers including the faculty members participating in the Research Work retain the right to publish freely any results of the Research Work provided such publication does not defeat the securing of intellectual property generated through the research.

### ARTICLE 4 : INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

4.1 All intellectual properties conceived, discovered and reduced to practice jointly by the Parties in accomplishing the Research Work or as an outcome of the Research Work shall be owned by the IITD.

### ARTICLE 5: INDEMNITY

5.1 In this Article "Claim" includes but is not limited to every phase of any lawsuit, loss, claim, damage or liability for death, illness or personal injury of any person (including employees of the Parties), property damage, and/or for infringement of intellectual property rights of a third party. #### ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

8.1 Any disagreement/ difference of opinion/ dispute between the Parties regarding the interpretation of the provisions of this Agreement or otherwise arising from this Agreement and the activities undertaken under this Agreement shall be resolved by mutual conciliation of the Heads of Institutions of the two Parties.

8.2 If any dispute remaining unresolved after conciliation as aforesaid, the said dispute shall be resolved by a sole arbitrator appointed by the Heads of Institutions of the two Parties


8.3 The arbitration shall be conducted under the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification / re-enactment thereof

8.4 The place of arbitration shall be Delhi and the proceedings shall be conducted in English language.

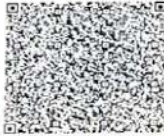

- c) Save as otherwise set out in this MOU, the termination of this MOU howsoever arising is without prejudice to the rights, duties and liabilities of either party accrued prior to termination.

#### 7. Confidentiality

- a) Each party hereto agrees with the other:
  - To keep information in strict confidence and secrecy.
  - Not to use the information save for complying with its obligations under this MOU.
  - Not to disclose the same to a third party other than the party's professional advisers and such employees of the other party on a need to know basis as per requirements of this MOU, who are under a similar duty to protect confidential information, or any third party having a legal right to obtain disclosure thereof.
- b) The restrictions contained in above clause shall apply to both the parties during the term of and for (one) year after the termination of this MOU but shall cease to apply to information or knowledge which:
  - Has in it's entirely become public knowledge otherwise than through any unauthorised disclosure or other breach of such restriction.
  - The other party has consented in writing to the same being disclosed.
  - Is or has been independently developed by the other party without reference to or use of the confidential information.
- c) Training data, particularly documents, videos, processes, multimedia files, presentations, and any such training resources that the Kamala Nehru College gains access during the contract will be kept confidential and not share in the public domain unless agreed upon by both parties.
