
"Each One, Teach One"

## THE PLEASANT VALLEY FOUNDATION

Dear Admissions Committee,

It is hard to overstate the meaningful contributions that Lakshita Ankem has made to our non-profit school and the surrounding community during her volunteer work from June 2022 to August 2022.

As the President of the Foundation who runs the School, I've had the pleasure of seeing Lakshita make profound contributions both in and out of the School. I can say with confidence that she is one of the most driven and caring student volunteers I've ever seen in my fifteen years of association with The Pleasant Valley School. We are a flexible, dynamic organisation that focuses on making education relevant to the families of the remote mountain communities in the Himalayan State of Uttarakhand and we support local people to become leaders in their communities and in their own lives.

Located in the Himalayan foothills about 420 kilometres away from Delhi from where she came, in the remote area of Hawalbagh, Lakshita battled harsh weather conditions and crossed treacherous mountain paths just to reach out to the local community which our Foundation has been helping. She blended seamlessly with our educational approach of combining academic excellence with life-affirming enrichment, all set in the natural beauty of the Himalayan foothills. She walked in the shadows, squeezed between gorges where the sun cannot penetrate properly. During her three months with our School and Foundation, she displayed resilience, adaptability, and a profound sense of empathy.

In one of the field trips, Lakshita observed that though the state of Uttarakhand has some of the best nature viewing spots in the world, the remote areas in Kumaon region do not have many professional trekking-coaches. In order to promote the idea of ethical and eco-friendly opportunities for the local people for trekking and nature viewing, she asked the local village leaders to give appropriate training to young villagers so that it will bring in some income without disturbing the balance of nature. She insisted that our Foundation should sponsor local men and women to attend Outdoor Leadership Certification courses with topics ranging from ropes and gear, to environmental and cultural awareness and risk assessment. To bring this knowledge to more kids at a younger age, as per Lakshita's earnest advice, we created an Outdoor Leadership Program as part of the curriculum at our School. This new program provides the students another option for their livelihood as they finish high school. Due to her efforts, thirty local adults participated in a Bird Festival at Munsiyari. Innovative people like Lakshita inspire our Foundation and make life better for many people in remote villages.

After interacting with the staff, Lakshita initiated a Himalayan Winter Clothing drive, her objective was to collect winter essentials for the underprivileged local children. To our surprise, she mobilised blankets for more than 60 families in a week's time. Her leadership qualities were evident as she organised and motivated a diverse team of volunteers, collaborated with local authorities, and ensured the project's sustainability for years to come. She was keen that we develop long-term relationships with local leaders, learning from and partnering with them. She is a selfless worker with a big heart and every day, she demonstrated exceptional work ethic.

In recent years, the global warming of the planet is starting to show its effects even in our cold Himalayan valleys. This year in particular, the temperatures have not dropped below zero in most villages surrounding our School and it became a real mission for her to be able to pass on the knowledge of climate change to the young ones in the School and elders outside in the villages. It is important to state that the way in which she interacted with students and the elderly was captivating.

What sets Lakshita apart is her ability to inspire those around her with her habits. Her daily morning runs among the mountains ignited a fervour for physical health and well-being among the staff and children. Always thinking about how institutions can better serve people, she propagated that local villagers should go for a homestay business that will provide an authentic farm experience and guided trekking in the Himalayas to visitors. Ever the attendee to detail, Lakshita identified a need and worked with the faculty to meet it in a beneficial way. She came up with different strategies to back up her ideas. She wanted our Foundation to popularise the concept of sustainable practices and looked for outdoor enthusiasts and entrepreneurs in Delhi to contribute and partner with local villagers in this Entrepreneurship Programme. As she was returning to Delhi after her tenure, our students, including the little ones who can barely recite the alphabet, were in tears.

Lakshita believes passionately in social progress and working for the common good. Her personal experiences drive her advocacy work. She is an intelligent student with charisma, confidence and strong values who strives to make a huge difference in the world around her. I am confident that she will be an outstanding fit for your Institution. Lakshita has my highest recommendation.

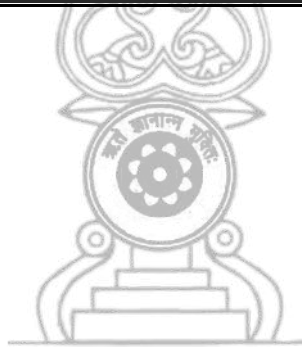

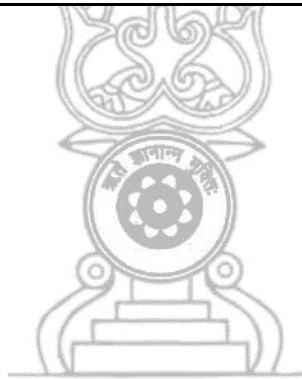

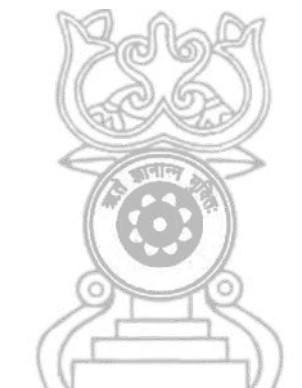
