Ragging as per UGC:

- 1. Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or a junior student.
- 2. Indulging in a rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student.
- 3. Asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

Anti-Ragging Committee - As per the direction of the Supreme Court of India and UGC guidelines, ragging within or outside any educational institute is prohibited which is strictly followed by Anti-Ragging Committee of Kamala Nehru College. Steps taken in our campus are as follow:

- Dr Mandeep Kaur is the Convenor (email <u>mkaurarora@knc.du.ac.in</u>; Mobile 9990185158), and Dr O P Koli (email <u>oprakash@knc.du.ac.in</u>; Mobile 9968048257) and Dr Deepak (email <u>deepakkumar@knc.du.ac.in</u>, Mobile 9911360060) are the faculty members of the Anti-Ragging Committee that coordinates the emerging situations related to ragging.
- If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of Anti-Ragging Committee/Proctorial Board/authority, an ad-hoc disciplinary committee is formed to resolve the issue. The concerned student is given liberty to explain herself to the members. If it is not found satisfactory, the authority would take the disciplinary action against the student.
- Awareness campaigns are organized in order to sensitize students. Posters are also circulated as per university guidelines.
- Strict vigilance by the Anti-Ragging team in regular intervals in college corridors and
 in the canteen areas, playground etc. inside the campus to keep an eye on any such
 development.
- Anti-Ragging Affidavit mandatorily signed by the student during their admission process.
