





WELCOME TO RAJASTHAN

Rajasthan, state of northwestern India, located in the northwestern part of the Indian subcontinent. It is bounded to the north and northeast by the states of Punjab and Haryana, to the east and southeast by the states of Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh, to the southwest by the state of Gujarat, and to the west and northwest by the provinces of Sindh and Punjab in Pakistan. The capital city is Jaipur, in the east-central part of the state.

Rajasthan, meaning "The Abode of the Rajas," was formerly called Rajputana. "The Country of the Rajputs" (sons of rajas [princes]). Before 1947, when India achieved independence from British rule, it comprised some two dozen princely states and chiefships, the small British-administered province of Ajmer-Merwara, and a few pockets of territory outside the main boundaries. After 1947 the princely states and chiefships were integrated into India in stages, and the state took the name Rajasthan. It assumed its present form on November 1, 1956, when the States Reorganization Act came into force. Area 132,139 square miles (342,239 square km). Pop. (2011) 68,621,012.

ECOLOGICAL IMPERIALISM

The term 'Ecological Imperialism' has been one of the most debated topics whether in history (past) or present and the same is going to happen in future marking the environmental condition.

Before going into the entire debate of understanding the human invasion, migration, historical analysis it is very imp to understand first that actually what does the term Ecological imperialism mean. Usually apart from political imperialism which we are aware of in 17th & 18th century another form of imperialism took place along with it which is known as Imperialism of European plants & animals.

Imperialism is basically a policy that involves a nation which is extending its power by the acquisition of land & by purchase, diplomacy or military force. Hence environmentalism is a heterogeneous mix of science, politics, ecology as well as culture. Environmentalism are inextricably linked to diverse influences and no single school is perhaps the most exciting moment of my time. Ecological imperialism is the theory advanced by Alfred Worsley that European settlers were successful in colonisation of other regions because of their accidental & deliberate introduction of animals, plants & disease leading to major shifts in the ecology of the colonised areas and to pop. collapse in the endemic region. Many pathogens they carried with them adversely affected the native populations of N America, Australia & Africa & were far more destructive than weapons: it is estimated that disease wiped




Attendance and Internal assessment
