ELECTION CODE OF CONDUCT

CAMPAIGNING RULES:

1. Candidates must campaign only on the days assigned for campaigning. Any campaigning done before or after will result in disqualification.
2. Candidates will be allowed to put only two printed posters. Rest of the posters should be handmade and put within the college campus. Printed banners, posters, flyers or pamphlets are not allowed.
3. Candidates should not disfigure or damage the College property in any manner during campaigning. Posters should not be stuck or nailed to the walls. Scotch tape may be used for putting posters.
4. Candidates must remove their posters from college on the last day of campaigning by 4:00 PM.
5. Candidates should not resort to any inappropriate means to seek votes. Votes sought on the basis of caste, community, religion or other such factors are extremely regressive and therefore condemned and discouraged.
6. Any kind of violence or disruption of college decorum during campaigning by any candidate will result in disqualification of the candidate.
7. No candidate or their supporters should be present at the election venue or its vicinity on the day of the election.
8. Parents, friends and relatives of the candidates or any outsider for that matter will not be permitted to enter into college premises on the day of election.
9. Violating any of the above rules will result in disqualification of the candidate.

VOTING RULES:


1. Candidates are allowed to vote. However, they must leave the election venue soon after casting their voting.
2. All students must bring their Identity Cards on the day of the election and produce it at the time of voting.
3. The students should put a tick mark against the name of their preferred candidate with a pen (pencil should not be used). Any other mark (for example two or more ticks, one tick and a cross, two crosses, names etc.) will make the vote invalid.

COUNTING RULES:

1. The counting will be done by teachers and office staff.
2. Invalid votes to be kept in a separate box.
3. Students are allowed to check the counted votes only on the day of the election and in the presence of the teachers.
4. If candidate wins by even one vote she will be declared as elected.
5. In case of tie, election will be held again for that post.

RULES GOVERNING ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES:

1. The elected candidate shall not be allowed to hold two offices at the same time.
2. The elected representative must work in good spirit with the intention of serving the students community at large.
3. They should not use their position for personal gains.
4. Strict action will be taken against any member indulging in any financial irregularity.
5. They must not indulge in any activity which brings disrepute to the College.
6. Any undesirable action taken by even one member will amount to collective responsibility and result in disqualification of the whole team. All members are expected to keep a check on the indulgement of any member in any undesirable activity and report such matter to the College authorities.
7. The team must exhibit exemplary leadership and set an example for the student community.
