

## **Report of Commerce department for January 2020- December 2020**

### **‘Webinar on Domestic Violence During Lockdown of Workforce - Concerns, Issues and Legal Remedies’:**

A webinar was conducted on Domestic Violence During Lockdown of Workforce -Concerns, Issues and Legal Remedies on 22<sup>nd</sup> May, 2020 from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. It was conducted via zoom platform. We had received 507 registrations which includes faculty members and students from various universities across the nation. (such as; University of Delhi, Lucknow University, University of Jammu, Panjab University, GGSIPU). The list also includes professionals from other fields such as lawyers, managers, bank officials, etc. The webinar was attended by 216 participants, out of which around 85% participation was witnessed from outside Kamala Nehru College.

Eminent speakers of the webinar were Mr. Amar Nath Gupta, Advocate, Supreme Court of India, Dr. Upma Gautam, Assistant Professor, University School of Law and Legal Studies, GGSIPU and Dr. Anita Tagore, Assistant Professor, Kalindi College, University of Delhi.

The webinar started with opening remarks given by Dr. Kalpana Bhakuni, Principal, Kamala Nehru College. The session proceeded with discussions on the present scenario and its impact on increasing domestic violence with people staying at home during the lockdown. The speakers discussed the increase in number of cases in domestic violence in this period. They shared various legal remedies to deal with the situation and introduced the participants to other modes of recourse such as emergency WhatsApp helpline launched by National Commission for Women (NCW). The situation in other countries was also discussed. This was followed by an interactive Question & Answer session.

The webinar was very informative, as it widened participants’ horizon and introduced them to various recourses in times of emergency situations related to domestic violence. The session ended with feedback from participants.

### **“Webinar on MBA – Make or Break Deal?”:**

A webinar was organised on the topic “MBA – Make or Break Deal?” on 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 from 11:00a.m. to 12.30 p.m. 3 eminent and experienced personalities, to help students clear their queries related to a Master’s in Business Administration were invited for the webinar.

We received 83 student registrations. Though most of them were from Commerce Department, some of them were from other departments such as Economics, Mathematics and History also. The webinar was attended by 65 students. 10 faculty members from Commerce Department also attended the event.

The session proceeded with an interactive question and answer session. Most of the questions were catered to and the speakers gave students a clearer picture related to MBA.
