

Report (2019)

The Geography department organized a series of events throughout the year 2019, engaging the students in enriching experiences. Geography Day, the annual day of the department was organized on the 4th November with a lot of zest among students. The session started with a film on Ladakh made by Dr Krishanand, along with a discussion by a senior geographer, Dr Premendra Parihar. Ms Bhamini Jain, climate activist interacted with the students and discussed various facets of climate change. The students organized other events like slam poetry, treasure hunt, quiz, pictionary etc. These events had participation from many undergraduate colleges of Delhi University.
