

Report 2021:

With the pandemic continuing its strangulating grip over all the spheres of life, Lakshya: The Theatre Society worked its way to educate and aware through art.

We made several short films, on topics like mental health, gender stereotypes, work environments etc. Several workshops for writing and acting purposes were arranged to make the most of whatever little opportunities were available. Participating in several competitions, the team secured first position in a short film making competition organised by Women Development Cell of DDUC (26/02/2021), first position in ad making (10-04-2021) and song writing (14-04-2021) competitions by PGDAV, first position in duet slam colloquy competition by St. Stephens (14-04-2021), and first position in 72 hours ad-making competition by SRCC (19-04-2021 to 23-04-2021). The team also made a shortfilm for a competition organised by MSIT, and one on the occasion of teachers day. In a first, the team also made its very first radio play. After a little relief in covid numbers, the team was back on the ground and prepared a play based on LGBTQIA+ community, and performed it at several competitions and preliminary rounds.

Apart from all this, the team organised an intra college open mic event as a part of 'Azadi ka Amrit Mohatsav' on the topic, Women of 21st century (18-08-2021). A few relevant workshops were also conducted.
