Report 2011-2012

2011 was a very active year for Expressions. Members attended events at various colleges across campus, including at Lady Shri Ram College, Ramjas College, Jesus and Mary College, Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, Janaki Devi College, Hindu College and the Indian Institute of Planning and Management. Our faculty convener Dr Rita Malhotra coordinated all the above programs.
