

Report of the Glitz Fashion Society, 2021

Glitz Fashion Society had organised a weeklong fashion fiesta 'Glamouresque' from 4th May - 12th May 2021. The event involved two categories namely- styling and makeup. The theme for the styling event was 'Timeless'. For this event, the participants had the floor to design 3 different looks from any era of their choice. For the makeup event, the theme as called 'Zodiac'. The participants for the makeup event were given the freedom to design a look on the basis of an element - earth, fire, water or air. The first position in the makeup category was bagged by Shreya Arora from Kamala Nehru college and Mansi Aggarwal was declared the second position in the same category. In the styling category, Reet Malik, from Kamala Nehru College secured the first prize. Glitz had remarkably performed well in several online fashion competitions across Delhi and outside Delhi.

The fashion society won the first position in 'Interpedo' organised by University Maharani College, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.
