

Report: 2011-2012

The fine arts society of KNC worked on varied levels during the last academic year. We began with an orientation for the first year students to make them aware of the kind of work that our society does. This was to encourage more students to become a part of it. We also organised for the first time a "Crafts Mela" at the college, where the art works of our students were put on display as well as sale.
