

# **IQAC Report**

## **July to December 2025**

Under streamlined guidance and continuous support of our Principal, and a strong dedicated team IQAC has conducted various programs for faculty members, students and administrative staff in the July-December 2025 session.

- IQAC in coordination with The Institute of Constitutional and Parliamentary Studies (ICPS) organised an event on “Empowering youth with knowledge about the Constitutional responsibilities and duties” on 25th August 2025.
- IQAC started a Lecture series on Indian Knowledge Systems. Two lectures were conducted on 8th August and 26th September.
- Academic Audit of all the departments was conducted on 8th and 9th October 2025.
- IQAC with ICC organised a workshop on Gender Sensitisation and the Prevention of Sexual Harassment Act 2013 on 16th October 2025.
- A training session was organised on “The latest issued assessment Guidelines for the fourth year” by Dr Sabeen Rizvi on 17th October 2025.
- IQAC with the Enabling unit and Samarthanam Trust organised the distribution of Menstrual Hygiene Kits for our KNC students. On 8th Nov 2025.
- IQAC under “Rise and Shine Mental Well Being” initiative of KNC organised A workshop on Suicide Prevention awareness in collaboration with Samrasa Foundation & Udisha foundation on 19th Nov. 2025.
- IQAC organised an open house on “Financial Empowerment: Planning for a Secure Tomorrow” on 27th Nov 2025.
- Screening of all the 29 applications for promotions from AL 10- Al 11 have been done and the panel is already taken up from the university. In the coming two weeks the process will be complete.
- Screening of applications for promotions from AL 13A- AL 14 is almost completed at college level. In January the next stage will be processed.
- WDC and IQAC in collaboration with Bharatiya Stree Shakti organised a panel discussion on Women Empowerment & Ambedkar on 9th December 2025.
- A lecture session on mentoring undergraduate research on 15th Sept, 2025 with Research and Collaboration Cell.

## January to July 2026

Under streamlined guidance and continuous support of our Principal, IQAC conducted various programmes for faculty members, students, and administrative staff in the January–July 2026 session.

- Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi, commemorated the 150th anniversary of *Vande Mataram* on 15 January 2026 with a special programme in the College Auditorium, graced by Prof. Yogesh Singh, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi, celebrating the song's enduring legacy in India's cultural and nationalist consciousness. The programme was graced by distinguished guests including Prof. Balaram Pani, Dean of Colleges, Dr. Vikas Gupta, Registrar, and Prof. Manoj Prasad, Chairperson, Governing Body Kamala Nehru College as Guests of Honour.
- Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi, organized an International Conference on “Leveraging the National Education Policy 2020 towards Viksit Bharat” on 20–21 March 2026, bringing together academicians, researchers, and students to critically engage with NEP 2020's role in fostering holistic, multidisciplinary, skill-oriented, and research-driven higher education aligned with the vision of Viksit Bharat 2047.
- KNC Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, in collaboration with Lakshya: The Theatre Society of Kamala Nehru College, under the aegis of the Rise and Shine Mental Well-Being Initiative, presented a street play on “Baal Vivah Mukht Bharat” on 18th February 2026 at Village Pijanji (Aliganj) to promote social awareness regarding child marriage and its impact on society.
- IQAC, through the Rise and Shine Mental Well-Being Initiative, in collaboration with Expressions: The English Creative Writing Society and Srijan: The Hindi Creative Writing Society, organized an Essay Writing Competition on “Bal Vivah Mukht Bharat: Protecting Childhood, Securing the Future” from 14th February to 23rd February 2026 to encourage social awareness, creative expression, and critical engagement among students.
- IQAC and the Department of Mathematics, Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi, organized a seminar on “Rediscovering Our Roots: The Indian Knowledge System in Mathematics” on 17th February 2026 at NSR, Kamala Nehru College, featuring distinguished speakers from Jawaharlal Nehru University to explore India's intellectual heritage and its relevance in contemporary mathematics and science.

- IQAC, Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi, in collaboration with MIT-World Peace University and in association with UNESCO, organized an Awareness Seminar on “Studying Peace and Conflict, Your Path to an Impactful Global Career” on 23rd April 2026 in the New Seminar Room, Kamala Nehru College, to promote awareness regarding peace studies, conflict resolution, and global career opportunities in the field.
- Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi, organized the “National Young Research Scholars’ Symposium 2026” on the theme “Inquiry and Insight: Research Perspectives in Contemporary Contexts” on 24th–25th April 2026 to provide a platform for young researchers in Humanities and Social Sciences to present interdisciplinary research and engage with contemporary academic issues.
- IQAC and the Library, Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi, organized a Hands-On Workshop on “Turnitin” on 5th May 2026 in Computer Lab 2 to promote academic integrity, originality in research, and understanding of plagiarism detection and similarity reports.
- Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi, has instituted an Award for Excellence in Research and Publication to encourage faculty and students of the College to publish high-quality research in reputed, high-impact national and international journals. The award aims to promote research excellence, enhance academic visibility, and foster a culture of research within the institution.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has undertaken several initiatives towards strengthening institutional infrastructure, accessibility, administrative efficiency, and academic support facilities. The major developments are as follows:

- The SLRM Committee of Kamala Nehru College organized an awareness programme on “Zero-Waste Management Practices” on 29 April 2026, where Shri Shashvat Saurabh, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Central Zone, MCD, highlighted the importance of sustainable waste management and responsible environmental practices in building a Zero-Waste Campus. Following sustained efforts towards sustainable waste management and environmental stewardship, Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi, was recognised as a “Zero Waste Institution” becoming

the first college in the University of Delhi to receive this distinction, reflecting its commitment to environmental sustainability and responsible campus practices.

- The Department of Posts, Government of India issued a special set of commemorative postage stamps celebrating the rich legacy and contribution of distinguished women's colleges of Delhi. Kamala Nehru College was honoured as one of the four institutions that featured in this prestigious release.
- The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) undertook a comprehensive structural audit of the college infrastructure to assess the structural safety, stability, and sustainability of the campus buildings.
- IQAC facilitated the installation of a lift in the college library to improve accessibility and ensure ease of movement for students, faculty members, staff, and differently-abled users.
- IQAC procured a salary package/software system to streamline salary processing, enhance administrative efficiency, and ensure timely financial management within the institution.
- IQAC upgraded the committee room with a modern video conferencing setup to facilitate online meetings, hybrid academic interactions, and administrative discussions.
- IQAC supervised the refurbishment and upgradation of the NSR to ensure the smooth conduct of academic, cultural, and institutional activities and to provide an improved environment for events and student engagement.
