

Report on the Summer School 2025 Program at Kamala Nehru College

Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi, successfully inaugurated its Summer School 2025 program on 6th June 2025 at 11:00 AM in the NSR Auditorium. The inaugural address was given by Prof. Pavitra Bhardwaj, Principal Kamala Nehru college, who emphasised on the significance of academic innovation and continuous learning as a requirement of contemporary times. The event was marked by an engaging and stimulating atmosphere which brought together students, faculty, and resource persons to launch an academic initiative aimed at providing interdisciplinary learning and engagement during the summer break. This initiative aims to reflect Kamala Nehru College's commitment to fostering intellectual curiosity and academic exploration beyond traditional classroom boundaries by offering a range of short term, rigorous courses that have been structured to equip students with critical insights and skills in contemporary relevant fields.

This year the summer school was organised in Collaboration with Industry experts like Symbiosis Skills and Professional University, Pune; Manipal University, Jaipur; Research Sikha; Rekhi Foundation for Happiness, and Vibes Beauty and Wellness. We offered eight certificate courses including: Market Research, Human Rights and Recruitment, Accounts Executive, Sustainable Finance (26), Blockchain and Cryptocurrency (14), AI Applications for Business, Science of Happiness, and Beauty and Wellness Counsellor with a total intake of participants. The courses were taught by industry experts and academics to provide theoretical depth as well as relevant practical skills.

The Summer School 2025 has an inclusive intent and is open to students across universities, whilst also encouraging an interdisciplinary participation in order to provide students an opportunity to collaborate across disciplines. The program unfolded over the following weeks and is reaching conclusion by the end of August, further solidifying Kamala Nehru College's reputation as an institution for inclusive and pioneering education which continues to be of relevance in this consistently changing world.
