The election for student representatives of the Students' Council of Kamala Nehru College will be held offline. Applications are invited for the following posts:

1. President (3rd / 4th year student)
2. Vice President (2nd year student)
3. Cultural Secretary (2nd Year Student)
4. Four Proctors (One from each year)

- **Declaration of Final List of Candidates:** 11th September 2026 - 5pm
- **Campaigning:** 12th - 14th September 2026
- **Presidential Debate:** 14th September 2026 at 1-1:30 pm at Chaupal
- **No Campaign Day:** 15th September 2026
- **Voting:** 16th September 2026 from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm
- **Counting and Declaration of Result:** 16th September 2026

CAMPAIGNING IN ANY FORM WILL NOT BE ALLOWED 24 HOURS PRIOR TO THE DAY OF ELECTION.

CANDIDATES AND VOTERS TO NOTE:

1. All candidates are required to furnish attendance record as per the university norms, verified by the admin office and duly self-attested and signed by Teachers-in-Charge.
2. Nominations form, Affidavit, NOC and the Undertaking form shall be provided in soft copy. The candidate is required to procure Stamp paper of Rs. 10 for the affidavit on their own.
3. All relevant form for the nomination to be submitted in hard copy in the Committee Room on 7th-9th September 2026 between 1:00 to 1:30pm, duly signed by the TIC of the department.
4. The candidate shall have ONLY one opportunity to contest for any post of office bearer.
5. Candidates applying for the post of President, Vice-President, Cultural Secretary and Proctors to interact with the Principal and Student Council Advisors on 9th and 10th September in college.
6. The only formal mode of campaigning will take place at Chaupal where candidates will introduce themselves to the students of KNC.
7. Voting rights are reserved only for bona fide students of KNC with I-Cards.
8. Only bona fide students can Propose and Second the names of the candidates.

9. Any student whose past record is found to be inappropriate shall be liable to be debarred from participation in Elections, without any prior notice. The decision of the College shall be final and no representation in this regard shall be entertained.
10. Proper discipline has to be maintained, and any act of indiscipline would come under the purview of disciplinary action as per College/DU Rules.
11. Students shall exercise responsibility, restraint and professionalism while using social media and other digital communication platforms. Students shall not create, publish, upload, share, transmit or circulate any content that is - false, defamatory, derogatory, abusive, obscene or otherwise unlawful against the College, its authorities, faculty members, staff, students or any member of the College or University of Delhi. Students shall not create, publish, upload, share or circulate any content that is likely to damage the reputation, dignity, privacy, safety or orderly functioning of the institution. Any misuse of the social media in violation of this Code may invite disciplinary action in addition to any civil or criminal liability arising under the relevant laws.

STUDENTS SHALL NOT:

1. Engage in bullying, harassment, intimidation, discrimination, violence, sexual misconduct, cyberbullying or any conduct that infringes upon the dignity, safety or rights of others.
2. Damage, vandalize, misuse, remove or unlawfully appropriate any property belonging to the College or any member of the College community.
3. Deface the college premises by sticking posters and banners etc.
4. Resort to falsification of records or any unfair means.
5. Disrupt teaching-learning processes, administrative functions, official meetings, cultural programs or any institutional activity.
6. Litter, dump, burn or improperly dispose the waste, including plastic, paper, food waste, e-waste or any other material within the College campus and shall comply with the **Zero Waste Policy** of the College. Any act of littering, improper waste disposal or violation of the Zero Waste Policy shall constitute misconduct and may invite disciplinary action.
7. Engage in any act that is unlawful or inconsistent with the statutes, ordinances, regulations, rules, policies or directions issued by the College, the University of Delhi, regulatory authorities or the Government.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

Any violation of this Code of Conduct shall constitute misconduct and may result in disciplinary proceedings. Depending upon the nature and gravity of the violation, the College may impose one or more of the following actions, without prejudice to any civil or criminal proceedings that may be initiated under applicable law:

- Written warning or reprimand.
- Monetary penalty, wherever permissible under applicable regulations.
- Suspension from classes, examinations, library, laboratories or other College facilities.

- Cancellation or withholding of scholarships, awards or institutional privileges.
- Debarment from participation in college activities.
- Withholding of examination results, certificates or recommendations, wherever permissible.
- Rustication or expulsion from the College, and/or
- Referral of the matter to the appropriate law enforcement or statutory authorities.

THE DECISION OF THE COLLEGE AUTHORITIES IN MATTERS RELATING TO DISCIPLINE, SUBJECT TO APPLICABLE LAWS AND THE RULES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF DELHI AND STATUTORY AUTHORITIES, SHALL BE FINAL AND BINDING. EVERY STUDENT SHALL BE DEEMED TO HAVE READ, UNDERSTOOD AND ACCEPTED THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CODE OF CONDUCT.
